(York, PA) — It was a pathway of giving that led Mike, a student at York County Literacy Council, to a free welding lesson on November 16 at EarlBeck Gases & Technologies, Aberdeen Road in York.

Mr. Travis Gentzler, President of Weldon Solutions, attended an October 24 Manufacturers' Association tour event at Association member EarlBeck Gases & Technologies, and his company was awarded a free welding lesson, donated by Earlbeck as part of the event.
